**Please note the following if you are training with CHI:**

**An inspection of your Helmet and Boots will be conducted prior to mounting and riding your horse. You will NOT be allowed to ride if you don't have an approved riding helmet and smooth soled boots in good repair with a distinct heel of no less than 2cm from the sole to the heel under the inner part of your foot.**

**Approved Safety Helmets Are:**

**AS/NZS 3838:1998 (current Australian Standard)**

**EN 1384 (current European Standard)**

**ASTN F1163 (current US Standard)**

**\*\* Hard hats MUST have a clearly readable manufacturers date inside the helmet. Please check your helmet – it must be LESS THAN 5 years from date of manufacture.**

**Classical Horsemastership International is VERY PROUD of the fact that we take all safety issues VERY seriously and that the advice we have been given is that hats must be no older than 5 years from date of manufacture to give the maximum protection possible. CHI considers that it would be irresponsible not to make all students and employees aware of this safety advice and CHI instructors are advised that they must not allow anyone to work with a horse unless the person is wearing a helmet which meets this criteria.**
